

## ONCE YOU TRY TWIN CRUISING...

"Personal contact with customers is important for us," he writes. "Many of them have become friends and we have an 85% come back of friends-customers, so we must do something right."

"Our main business is with private tours. That's normally from one up to six motorcycles, it's friends that want to be together and not with an unknown group of motorcyclists from different places. We can also take more people, then we split the group to have a maximum of six motorcycles per group and per Tour Guide. If people want to spend more time to see or do this or that, then we wait and adapt our itinerary accordingly. We put a program together according to the questionnaire we send and from there work out a price.

"Our prices are transparent and include everything. There are no hidden costs; each customer knows exactly how much the tour is going to cost. Prices include such things as petrol, taxes and levies including tolls. Non-alcoholic drinks with your meals are included, and your bike sleeps in a garage or under a roof or a parking with video control.

"For the partner that maybe does not want to ride every day but wants to pamper herself or why not himself, we can arrange for a massage, a facial, a pedicure, a sauna, do shopping, visit a castle or another highlight in the region, etc..

"Our upper class accommodations are only a small family run business. These owners identify themselves with the work they do and they are proud and have pleasure in what they offer you. The chicken you eat does not

come from a battery farm; no they can tell you where the farmer lives and even the name of the chicken. (Okay, I'm kidding about that.)

"With Twincruiser-Tours you see the World from a different point of view. See it like an insider and not as a tourist. Our homepage is getting a revamp and it will change to Twincruiser-Tours ([www.twincruiser-tours.com](http://www.twincruiser-tours.com)) but [www.twincruiser.org](http://www.twincruiser.org) will stay for at least two years."
